Dress Code

Introduction:

Following consultation with our school community the School Board has determined the following Dress Code for North Beach Primary School.

This Code reflects the values of our School and provides a balance between the rights of individual students and the best interests of the school community.

The Dress Code applies:

- During School hours;
- Whilst travelling to and from school; and
- When students are engaged in school activities.

It is our school expectation that all students will comply with the Dress Code.

Rationale:

North Beach Primary School has established a Dress Code for the following reasons.

A school Dress Code:

- Assists in building a school identity.
- Assist in building school and team spirit.
- Encourages equity between students by reducing peer pressure.
- Contributes to student safety, comfort and wellbeing.
- That is a cost-effective option for parents.
- Ensure all students are dressed safely, comfortably and appropriately for School activities.

Health and Safety:

- Students should ensure that they take appropriate action to protect themselves from the sun when outdoors. The NO HAT, NO PLAY school policy applies across the year. Broad brimmed hats are available from the uniform shop. Students who do not wear a hat will be restricted to the undercover area during recess and lunch breaks. During sport they will be placed in a supervised, shaded area.
- No thongs or beach sandals are permitted (except during In-Term Swimming Lessons). Appropriate sports shoes, school shoes or school sandals are to be worn at all times.
- Jewellery: Neck chains are discouraged. For safety reasons, children may wear the following items of jewellery only: Earrings (studs or sleepers) and a watch.
- For health and safety reasons, hair that is at, or below, shoulder length, and/or covers a student's face must be tied back at all times.

Logistics:

- All uniforms items, including school and sports clothing, bags, hats, hair accessories and socks are available to order from the Uniform Shop.
- Second hand clothing may be purchased from the Uniform Shop when available.

- Hats – Legionnaires Hat – Kindy and Pre-Primary only.
- Bucket Hat – Years 1 to 6.
- Kindy t-shirt – introduced 2021

Optional:

- Maroon Knee High Socks
- School Bag
- Hair Accessories

Students who do not comply with the School Dress Code may be prevented from any activity in which the student is representing the school provided, in the opinion of the principal, it is not part of the education program.
