About our incredible P&C

North Beach Primary School has an active Parents and Citizens (P&C) Association with a number of working groups in place to support us driving towards our goals. We are very proud to operate an onsite canteen and uniform shop which are run almost solely through our amazing volunteers.

Our goals are:

- to foster warm, strong connections between parents, caregivers and teaching staff
- promote transparent, open communications within our school community
- support school activities and programs
- identify and fundraise for areas of growth and improvement for the school such as educational resources or upgrading the school grounds and equipment
- strengthen the links between school and the wider community

We welcome you to participate in NBPS P&C events, activities and meetings. It's a great way to support your child's education, get to know other parents and caregivers and keep up-to-date with what is happening at the school!

Joining our P&C

Membership is open to all parents and carers of pupils attending the school and to all citizens within the school community.

You can simply attend a meeting to listen and share thoughts or, if you wish to be eligible to vote on decisions, join the NBPS P&C as a Financial Member.

Financial Members decide how fundraising money is spent. Financial Members can also be nominated for positions on the Executive Committee.

The **Executive Committee** consists of a President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary. Positions are voted on by financial members to co-ordinate the running of the P&C association. P&C Executive roles become available every March, at our Annual General Meeting (AGM).

What we do

At the beginning of each school year, the NBPS P&C and school representatives meet to discuss the annual wishlist for our school. These items are prioritised, discussed and voted on at our P&C Meetings.

How we do it

As a P&C, we meet on the third Tuesday of every term at 7pm in the staffroom. In March, we hold an AGM to vote in our Executive Members.

Our Canteen

Our Canteen is operated by the P&C and run by our wonderful Canteen Manager. The Canteen's purpose is to provide students and staff with nutritional foods and promotes healthy food choices.

Opening hours - Wednesday and Friday.

Menu - based on the traffic light system, we offer everyday favourites and have a regular special, advertised through Dojo, class representatives and our Facebook page.

Ordering - is placed online via Quickcliq. (www.quickcliq.com.au).

Recess - Students from Year 1 to Year 6 can attend the canteen to collect or purchase their recess items. Students in Kindy and Pre-Primary are not able to order recess.

Lunch - Lunch orders can only be made by using the online platform QuickCliq. Students can purchase after lunch snacks at the counter. These items can be paid for with cash (correct money encouraged) or ordered ahead of time online.

Volunteering in the canteen

Each week we have 4 shifts available for volunteers:

Wednesday 9.00am-11.30am
Wednesday 11.00am - 1.00pm

Friday 9.00am-11.30am
Friday 11.00am - 1.00pm

Our Uniform Shop

It is the policy of the P&C Association and School Board of North Beach Primary School that each child wears the full school uniform. As a minimum, students are required to wear NBPS yellow polo accompanied by a maroon short, skirt or pant*.

On sports days, students from pre-primary and above are required to wear their faction shirt.

We are delighted to have an onsite Uniform Shop which is managed by the P&C. Our Uniform Shop Coordinator volunteers their time to operate our uniform shop.

Opening hours - alternate Friday's aligned with the school assemblies.

Catalogue - of uniforms can be viewed through Quickcliq.

Ordering - is placed online via Quickcliq. (www.quickcliq.com.au) or instore.

The dress code for our kindy students is a little different from the rest of the school.

Kindy students are not required to wear the standard uniform. If parents and caregivers wish for their child to wear a uniform, a dedicated blue kindy t-shirt is available to order.

It is preferred that kindy students do not wear the standard uniform as it allows the teachers to clearly distinguish kindy students from pre-primary in the shared playground.

Our canteen relies on the wonderful parents, caregivers, grandparents, aunts and uncles who generously volunteer their time to lend a hand in the canteen.

Social and fundraising events

To share the load, event support throughout the year has been allocated to year groups, however we welcome and encourage volunteers from all year groups to support all our fundraising efforts.

Uniform Shop

Volunteer as one of our wonderful Uniform Shop Coordinators or volunteer with assisting with the processing, packing orders and delivery on in-store and online orders.

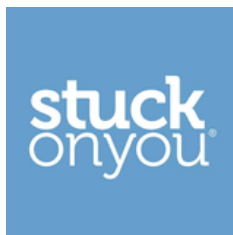
